## **Workshop Summary:**

This workshop is organized by the Asia-Pacific Journal of Public Health (APJPH) in conjunction with the 55<sup>th</sup> Asia-Pacific Academic Consortium for Public Health (APACPH) Conference. This workshop aims to meet individual and institutional needs to enhance research and acquire comprehensive knowledge and skills to write and publish a quality scientific manuscript. There will be an emphasis on the common errors made in undertaking research and presenting it in a way that editors will accept your paper for publication. We will provide an outline of an academic article and examples of common errors in the workbook provided to attendees. We will also share an overview of running a public health journal and the roles and responsibilities of journal editors. The workshop will also include an introduction to journal indexing. Major indexing services like PubMed, Journal Citation Reports (Impact Factors), and Scopus (CiteScore) will be addressed. For articles that are published, we will also provide information on the different types of article metrics available to assess the impact of your work, such as downloads and citations. Publication ethics is an important topic in scientific publishing, and we will be sharing on tackling conflicts of interest, authorship issues, data fabrication, plagiarism, and other misconducts. The target for the workshop is public health students, researchers, academic staff, journal editors, and reviewers who conduct research and need to develop successful scientific writing skills.
